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I have always turned to self-portraiture, familiar yet confronting, as the modality through which I can best express my concepts. I paint reflections of my internal landscape, conceptually layered, surreal and often subtly satirical. The work explores my journey, as a bleeding heart and perseverant mind in a fragile body, through an increasingly toxic world.

My compositions are carefully contrived, from the design and construction of elaborate props to palette choice and conceptual devices. I relish the craft of creating a visual narrative within a singular, static image. Similarly, I love the interplay between contemplative space and ornate detail, juxtaposition of the commonplace with the wonderfully strange.

There is a dichotomy between the warrior and the acutely vulnerable that often underpins my representation of self. I am the canary uncaged, traversing the wilds between fragility and freedom. Mine is a world where female archetypes, psychological machinations and the ever-evolving trials of this contemporary epoch collide in a timeless grasp for identity that bestrides the bounds of the ordinary.

BIOGRAPHY

Within 12 months of graduating from NMIT's School of Visual Arts, Lix's work caught the eye of revered gallerist and Auckland Art Fair founding director Jennifer Buckley, seeing her secure her first solo show at one of Auckland's most enduring and respected contemporary galleries, the Oedipus Rex. Three years on she became the youngest artist published in E.M. Caghey's book 'Art New Zealand Today' (Saint Publishing, 2003).

Lix cites a childhood in the stunning isolation of New Zealand's hill country as the catalyst for her ever-active imagination and unique way of seeing the world. In 2007 she settled in Brisbane, Australia, spending the majority of the ensuing decade as a professional illustrator, photographer and commission artist under the name of her graphic art studio, Lix Creative.

2016 saw Lix return her focus to conceptual fine art and exhibition, kicking off her comeback as the People's Choice winner in the 2016 Clayton Utz Art Award, category winner in the Lethbridge 10,000 and finalist in the 2018 Portia Geach Memorial Award.
